

Sir Keith Morris

Ambassador to Colombia (1990-1994), United Kingdom

Widely recognized for his expertise on Colombia and international drug trafficking issues, Sir Keith Morris was the United Kingdom's Ambassador to Colombia from 1990 to 1994. He also spent a year at the Royal College of Defence Studies (1986) and was advisor to Control Risks Group (1995-2008), as an international political and security risk consultancy.

After studies at Cambridge University and at Amherst College, Mass., Sir Keith Morris joined the British Diplomatic Service in 1959 and served in Dakar, Algiers, Bogotá, (1967-1971), Warsaw, Mexico, Milan and once again in Bogotá, (1990-1994). In 1996, Sir Keith founded and chaired the British & Colombian chamber of commerce, and since 1999 has served as a director.

Sir Keith was a Visiting Research Fellow at the Institute for Latin American Studies, London, from 1995-2000, and currently serves on the international advisory board of the Bogotá law firm, Parra, Rodriguez, Cavelier.
